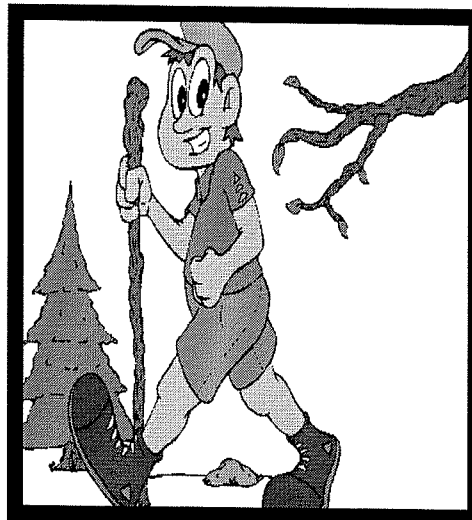
SAFE TRAVELS

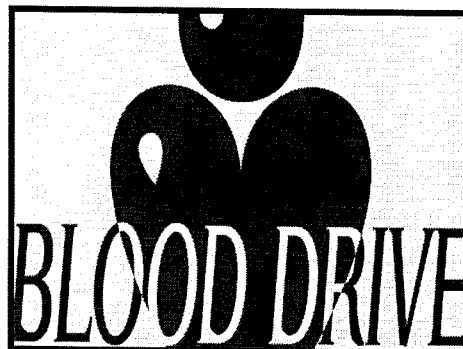
